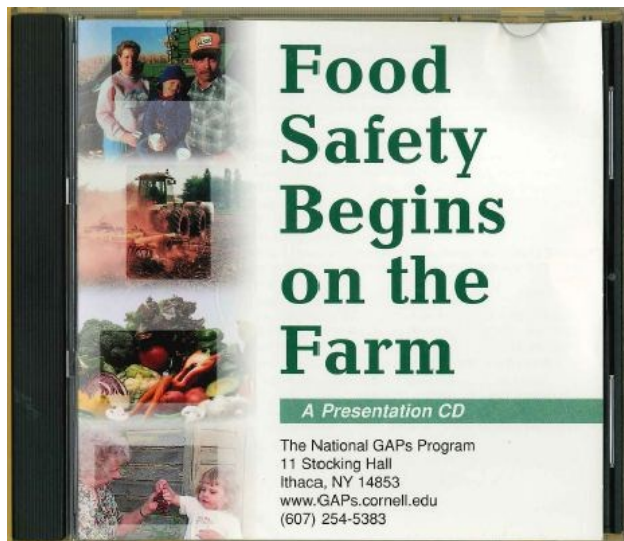


## Safe Food Handling Video For Educating Employees of Food Producers/Processors
